CRYPTO & COFFEE

The market traded broadly lower, even as the options market continued to point to lower volatility levels and as market positioning, 3 and 6 months out began to show early signs of bulls returning. This was particularly evidenced in the longer end, which finally turned from bearish bias to flat. Despite the lacklustre price action, Bitcoin remained in a bullish upward price channel and a re-test on \$6.8/7.0k levels is expected to take place in the coming days.

In terms of news flow, CoinDesk writes that an amended complaint against Ripple has been filed by XRP investors in a long-running lawsuit involving allegations of breaches to U.S. securities law. The amended lawsuit against Ripple now offers theory that XRP may not be a security.

As a reminder, XRP has been one of the better performing assets lately, spurred on by the pro-currency digitization calls, as well as further developments related to DeFi projects that will include ability to use XRP as collateral.

In other news, the CTO for Tether believes the USDT stablecoin can inject much-needed liquidity and stability into the emerging DeFi space. Elsewhere, Proof-of-stake (PoS) blockchain Cardano (ADA) went live with its Byron reboot, as the project prepares its transition to the Shelley mainnet.
