Yet again, the market failed to maintain upside bias and by the end of the session Bitcoin was trading just below \$9,200 area. Similarly, Ethereum traded in tandem with Bitcoin, creeping ever so lower during the closing hours of trade. The move lower came in spite of another bullish report by digital asset manager Grayscale Investments, which unveiled a record-breaking second quarter. The report highlighted that inflows into its trust funds amounted to over \$900 million of cryptocurrency. The fund manager's total inflows for the first half of 2020 now adds up to \$1.4 billion across its range of crypto funds—the majority in Bitcoin—according to its Q2 highlights report. It added that 85% of the money came from institutional investors.

Interestingly, investor attention is starting to diverge away from Grayscale's Bitcoin's trust and into its altcoin products. In Q2, \$135.2 million was committed to the Grayscale Ethereum Trust—marking an all-time high. Further, the firm's Litecoin Trust and its Bitcoin Cash Trust witnessed their largest inflow since Q2 2018.

Elsewhere, in another positive development for DeFi, it was reported that technology focused hedge fund Three Arrows Capital and tech VC Framework Ventures announced a \$3 million investment in DeFi lending protocol Aave.
